NAILING




IMPORTANT - Always nail the roof sheets through the crown of the corrugation, never through the gulley.



NEAT NAILING - Nail vertically until the nail head makes firm contact with the crown of the corrugation.



TIPS



PRIOR TO MAKING HORIZONTAL CUTS GIVE YOUR SAW BLADE A FEW SQUIRTS OF LUBRICATING OIL IT'LL MAKE THE JOB A LOT EASIER.
